

Generic Information to work for Euro-Divers Worldwide:

1. You must be registered at the PADI local area office in active teaching status: PADI Europe for Spain, Egypt, Oman and the Maldives. PADI Asia Pacific for Thailand and Indonesia.
2. When any visa/work permit is required, it will be provided; you must follow necessary visa/work permit procedures as advised hereafter. A full "information package" will be forwarded to you upon confirmation of your employment.
3. Your passport must have a validity of at least one year or more if required by local Immigration Authorities.
4. You must have your own complete diving gear as per the standards required by any course you are able to teach. The equipment must be in good working condition and presentation. With some airline companies, we benefit of 10kg extra luggage allowance. Any fees taken by Airlines for excess of luggage would be at your own costs.
5. You must have your own Instructor Manual (CD-ROM version if you want to save some weight while travelling), course outlines and training aids such as slates.
6. You must have a proper diving insurance including recompression chamber treatment and evacuation; minimum coverage should be equivalent to the DAN Basic Professional insurance program (for reference consult: www.daneurope.org – email: mail@daneurope.org). Liability insurance is provided by Euro-Divers.

Visa requirements for the Maldives:

To work in Maldives you will need a local visa and work permit; our agents in Male', IMAD's Agency, will process them for you. Following procedures must be respected:

1. You will need to provide: copy of passport (validity more than one year), copy of PADI certification showing renewal sticker – active status – from current year and a police report from your country showing a clean criminal record with a translation in English.
2. The three documents must be sent by DHL / EMS / Chronopost (registered mail is not reliable in terms of time, but acceptable if you send the papers more than one month before starting date) to our office in Male'. (Address in the information package).
3. Once received and within one month of your start, the work permit will be processed and a copy sent to you by fax or e-mail.
4. On arrival you must fill in an entry form and state "work" as purpose of the visit and show your work permit copy to the immigration officer.
5. After arrival, you will have to pass a medical examination at the local hospital (checking mainly AIDS and other contagious diseases), which is a requirement for your visa.

Visa requirements for Indonesia:

To work in Indonesia you will need a visa and a work permit. Prior to your departure, following procedure must be respected:

1. You will need to send to us:
 - a. Copies of **all pages** of your Passport (validity more than one year)
 - b. Copies of all diving certificates and / or diplomas in English
 - c. Recommendation letter of previous job experience
 - d. Curriculum Vitae
 - e. 2 x Photo (4 cm x 6 cm)
2. The above documents must be sent by DHL / EMS / Chronopost (registered mail is not reliable in term of time.) The process will take approximately 2-3 weeks. The Papers should be sent to our Dive Centre Manager – See address in your information package.
3. Once approved, the work permit will be sent to the embassy overseas (where you will apply for your visa). With this confirmation the embassy will stamp your working visa stamp in your passport.
4. On arrival you must fill in an entry form and state "work" as purpose of the visit and show your work permit copy to the immigration officer.
5. After arrival, you will go to the immigration office to get the working permit pass.

Visa requirements for Thailand:

To work in Thailand you will need a work permit. Following procedures must be respected:

1. Before entering Thailand, you must obtain a **Non-Immigrant B-Visa** at a Thai Embassy or a Consulate. Ask for a 1 year visa, some Embassy / Consulate will give max. 3 months; it's fine to start the work permit procedure.
2. Euro-Divers will provide you the necessary documents needed to apply for this visa.
3. You would have to provide us a postal address where all documents can be sent.
4. We would need to know which Thai Embassy or Consulate you intend to go for your visa (name and address) before we send you the documents.

On arrival in Thailand, you must fill in an entry form and state "work" as purpose of the visit. After your arrival and with your Non-Immigrant B-Visa stamped in your passport we will obtain your work permit locally.

Visa requirements for Egypt:

To work in Egypt you will first need a tourist visa. You can obtain this visa at any Egyptian Embassy in your country or get it at the airport upon arrival (just before going through immigration). The cost of the visa on arrival at the airport is 15.00 Euros.

1. The visa will give you the right to stay for 30 days and can be extended at the Hurghada Passport Section for another 30 days. For this extension, you will need your passport (validity more than one year), two passport pictures and one photocopy of your passport.
2. For more details on how to obtain the future work permit, please refer to your information package.

Visa requirements for Spain:

To work in Spain, you would need to hold a passport from the European Community with more than 1 year validity. Please bring along with you your diving diplomas.
