<b>Best Diving Season:</b> + Relevant climate info (Temp., visibility, wind etc...)	<p>December to April temp is 25c to 30c, water temp is 20c to 24c. Wind is more steady during this time. Sunny weather with few days of clouds, seldom rain.</p> <p>May to November temp is about 30c to 45c and the water is 29c. Sunny weather, can be very hot when the trade winds stops.</p>
<b>Type of diving:</b> Shore/ boat, max depth, current, Landscape (reef, sand, plateau etc...), distance	All the dive are conducted from boats, the max depth is 30 meters, most of the dive are along the reef, drop off or plateau. Closest site is 60min, farthest is 120min. Average in between.
<b>Highlights</b> Name + type of dive + description of main sea life	<p><b>Umm Gamar :</b> Long Plateau with Drop Off, Particular topography with long "chimney" pinnacles from 30m to 12m, along the wall. Batfish, Morey Eels hunting, Napoleon Fish, Yellow Spotted Trevallies, Triggerfish, Crocodile Fishes Lionfish, Nudibranch...</p> <p><b>Gota Shab El Erg:</b> Big Pinnacle separated from the main reef with a 40m wide pass. Dolphins can be seen frequently all year round in the lagoon. Around the site is found Scorpion Fish, Leopard Grouper, Moray Eels, Blue-Spotted Stingrays, Blue trigger fish. Of course, loads of Clown Fish in their Anemone. Rich with Coral in the shallows.</p> <p><b>Saqwa Abu Galawa:</b> Drift Dive possible from North to South. Very wide site, 3 to 4 different dives possible. Plateau with Coral Garden on one side (12M) with typical Red Sea life, along the Reef at 14m on the other side meeting Giant Moray Eels, Pipefishes, Huge Gorgoneas until reaching a stunningly beautiful shallow Coral Garden on the other side, home to a couple of Turtles and a Stargazer, and in the middle of the site, a Sandy Shallow Dead End, extremely rich with Corals and Cornetfishes breeding, if lucky, Cuttlefishes and Octopuses. Stonefishes, Lionfishes, Shrimps and Nudibranchs all over the site. Perfect for UW Photography.</p> <p><b>Ghiannis D :</b> Very famous wreck on Abu Nuhas. Large potato cod often hang out to the north and free swimming morays are common. Rabbitfish and parrotfish graze the algal moss that covers the metalwork, and variety of nudibranchs.</p>
