Terms

1. This certificate supersedes all previously issued for this Organisation and is valid for a period of 12 months from the date of this certification. Failure to achieve repeat certification within the prescribed time frame will result in the removal of certification and authority to dive.
2. This certificate authorises the Organisation to conduct commercial diving in support of the Ministry of Defence in accordance with the associated Commanding Officer Duty Holder (CODH) instruction of delegation.
3. The Organisation is certified, provided all diving is conducted in accordance with relevant ACOP (DWR 97) & DCOP 02. Diving plant must be operated in accordance with relevant operator guidance and equipment documentation.
4. The validity of this certificate is subject to an Operating Duty Holder Intermediate Verification (IV) audit of the Diving Safety Management System and is to be conducted in the 12-24 month (inclusive) period from certification. Failure to conduct the IV in the prescribed time frame will result in removal of certification and authority to dive.
5. The validity of this certificate is also subject to rectification of any Major Safety Observations identified in the associated audit report.
6. This certificate shall be held by the Organisation and displayed in a prominent place.
7. It is the responsibility of the associated CODH to ensure that for the period of certification, the highest possible safety standards are maintained and that a functioning and effective diving safety management system remains in place.
8. The Certificate will become invalid if:
 - a. It has expired.
 - b. It has been withdrawn (only by SofD).
 - c. IV has not been achieved in the prescribed time frame.
 - d. The Organisation ceases to be engaged in MoD sponsored diving.
 - e. Any specified condition or Major Safety Observation has not been addressed by its due date.
 - f. Deficiencies in the evidence supporting Certification and which undermine the case for Certification are discovered and not communicated to the Diving Standards Team at the earliest opportunity.
